





TRINIDAD & TOBAGO

- Completed the **output report** for the National
- Launched the **KAP Survey**, with **242** responses

- Joined PROMAR, IMA, MPEAD, EMA, and CNIRD —collecting over **1,680 kg** of waste, including **448** kg of plastics.





SURINAME

- **Pilot** options refined to guide next steps.
- Engaged 474 students across 7 secondary schools in hands-on environmental learning.
- Reached **270 visitors** at the Green Awareness Expo through interactive displays.
- West Suriname cleanup mobilized **22 volunteers** and removed 198.45 kg of waste.
- Finalized ToR for EPR and Waste Management regulations.
- Submitted baseline reports for review.
- Partnered with the Torarica Group to replicate sampling activities and explore new interventions.
- Celebrated World Cleanup Day 2025 with 721 participants across 24 sites in 6 districts—collecting **4.6 tons** of waste, including **2 tons** of plastic!
- Teamed up with the Galibi Indigenous Community for two cleanups—collecting nearly 700 kg of waste from the village and nearby turtle nesting beach.





GUYANA

- CYEN, through the University of Guyana, hosted its second beach cleanup at Kingston Seawall on June 28, collecting **67.5 kg** of litter with strong community support.
- Completed the **draft report** on the National Dialogue for Marine Litter Prevention and Plastic Waste Management.
- Finalized the Circular Economy Project concept and began discussions with a potential local partner.
- Submitted the **pilot project** proposal.
- Over 120 volunteers joined the International Coastal Cleanup at 63 Beach, Berbice, collecting **1,216 kg** of waste along 0.6 miles.
- Held school sessions at Mon Repos, Martyr's Ville, and Lusignan, engaging 130+ students on marine litter and environmental care.
- Trapped **4,900 kg** of litter in September!














ST. KITTS AND NEVIS

- Partnered with ICDF Taiwan to expand recycling initiatives
- Conducted a waste segregation exercise to inform the upcoming baseline report.
- Targeted two gullies for clean-up and waste collection with support from the Urban Development Corporation.
- Collaborating with the Department of Environment to host five stakeholder meetings on strengthening plastic ban enforcement.
- **Training** enforcement agencies to boost compliance efforts.
- Teaming up with the Taiwanese Cooperation to ramp up awareness and communication campaigns.




BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS

- Completed the second round of **beach sampling**, adding new data to the beach litter database.
- Drafted the Circular Economy Solutions
 Paper and Policy Output Paper.
- Continued **collaboration** with the Ministry for Environment to **advance the single-use plastic ban.**
- Conducted **beach sampling and cleanups** with summer camps and schools.
- Selected Long Bay Beach, Beef Island, as the **pilot site**.
- Launched the PROMAR website page and video.
- Finalized the Baseline Report.




NEXT STEPS
